Day 1: Wednesday, December 9, 2026 Overnight Flight Set out on a holiday adventure through the iconic capital cities of Central Europe – Prague, Vienna and Budapest. Along the way, immerse yourself in festive Christmas markets, enjoy traditional entertainment, sample local cuisine, and glimpse this region's rich history.

Day 2: Thursday, December 10, 2026 Prague, Czech Republic Ancient landmarks and medieval architecture. You've arrived in Prague, the "City of 100 Spires." With no scheduled activities throughout the day, spend the day as you wish, exploring the city independently. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. (D)

Day 3: Friday, December 11, 2026 Prague Feel the magic and wonder of Prague during the holiday season. Your introduction to this fairy-tale city begins with a panoramic tour. Explore the "Castle District," including the gothic St. Vitus Cathedral and the majestic Prague Castle. Marvel at the iconic, statue-lined Charles Bridge, a picturesque structure stretching over the Vltava River. Spend the rest of the day taking in the best Prague has to offer independently. Don't miss the famous Christmas market in Prague's Old Town Square, where brightly decorated wooden huts are filled with the work of local artisans, and traditional food and drink are prepared right in front of you. Day 4: Saturday, December 12, 2026 Prague - Dresden, Germany - Prague, Czech Republic Travel to Dresden, Germany, known as "Florence on the Elbe." Meet a local guide for a tour highlighting its baroque splendor and architectural treasures such as Frauenkirche (Church of Our Lady) and the Royal Palace. Visit the world's oldest Christmas market — the Striezelmarkt — which has been delighting travelers and locals alike since 1434. Take time to explore the stalls overflowing with ornaments, sample local sweets and get lunch on your own before returning to Prague later in the afternoon. (B)

Day 5: Sunday, December 13, 2026 Prague - Český Krumlov - Vienna, Austria Depart Prague and travel through the scenic countryside on your way to Vienna, Austria. En route, stop in the medieval town of Český Krumlov. Lined with towering Baroque architecture including a 13th century castle, explore the quaint, cobblestoned streets independently and take time for lunch on your own. Continue to the one-of-a-kind Marchfelderhof Restaurant — a favorite of locals, visitors, and the famous alike since the 1800s. Indulge in dinner and admire the restaurant's plentiful, eclectic décor which tells Vienna's story everywhere you look. Arrive in the grand city of Vienna, capital of Austria, aglow with holiday lights. Perhaps you'll join your Tour Manager for an evening stroll. (B, D)

Day 6: Monday, December 14, 2026 Vienna This morning, meet your local guide on a scenic bus ride and walking tour to Vienna's city center and behold the beautiful architecture, scenic parks, and gothic spires that fill the city. Get a taste of Vienna's sweet confectionary history when you visit a family-owned candy workshop. See where candies are still being made according to traditional recipes dating back over 150 years. With an afternoon of free time, you can visit the Christkindlmarkt. Perhaps the biggest and most famous in the city, it is set at the neo-gothic Rathaus City Hall. Tonight, you may choose an option to explore the Christmas market and the interiors at the magnificent Schönbrunn Palace, together with a classical music performance at the famous Orangerie. (B)

Day 7: Tuesday, December 15, 2026 Vienna - Bratislava, Slovakia - Budapest, Hungary Hop aboard a train to Bratislava, the former Imperial capital of the Habsburg Empire. Spend your free time having lunch and retracing some of the city's 4,000-year-old history independently. And don't miss the charming Christmas markets! Continue through the Hungarian countryside to spend an afternoon at a rustic local restaurant that highlights 200 years of Hungarian cultural and architectural traditions. Day 8: Wednesday, December 16, 2026 Budapest This morning, choose how you want to experience Budapest with an expert

local guide because **it's your choice!** Embark on a classic Budapest city tour, where you'll visit highlights like the Fisherman's Bastion and pass the historic Old Buda **-OR-** retrace Budapest's musical history throughout the city before visiting The House of Music Hungary. This afternoon, explore Budapest on your own with free time. Perhaps you will visit the cozy Christmas market at St. Stephen's Basilica with its ice rink and striking Christmas tree, or head to the city's largest market at Vörösmarty Square brimming with food and crafts stalls where local musicians often perform. This evening, join your fellow travelers to toast the end of a festive trip at a farewell dinner. (B, D)

Day 9: Thursday, December 17, 2026 Budapest - Tour Ends Say goodbye to these regal cities as your spirited holiday tour wraps up today. (B)

Experience It! Christmas Markets

Few things invoke the feel of old-world holiday traditions more than the spectacular European Christmas Markets. From November until Christmas these outdoor markets dot the Imperial Cities like a string of ornaments on a tree. Be transported back in time to a winter wonderland of open-air market stalls brimming with ornaments, handmade crafts, specialty food and warming beverages. Watch people spin on the ice of the outdoor rink in Vienna, see its lovely carousel and twinkling light installations. Prague is particularly lovely in the Advent season when its squares are festively transformed, and you can shop and sip to your heart's content as classical musicians perform, and choirs sing timeless songs of the season. Good cheer abounds in Budapest's largest market which glistens against the backdrop of the city's gorgeous St. Stephen's Basilica. Indulge in a timeless European holiday on this very special Christmas Markets tour.

Important Tour Information:

Book Now rates valid until Jun 10, 2026, valid on air inclusive packages only.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 3. This means you're an on-the-go traveler. You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for longer periods of time (2-3 hours) isn't a big deal. A moderately paced two-and-a-half-hour walking tour, covering several miles, hills, and uneven surfaces, is no problem for you. Walking four miles over the course of a day is very doable, as is climbing into and out of various modes of transportation (tuk-tuk, cable car, zodiac, etc.). You can climb three flights of stairs easily and handle altitudes between 6,000 and 9,000 feet. Expect some longer days with early mornings or late nights balanced with free time to recharge or set out on your own adventure. This level is not a fit for travelers who require mobility assistance devices.

Travel with an average of 37 people (maximum of 44).

If you require any special assistance while on tour, please make us aware at time of reservation so the necessary request form can be sent to your attention.

In Prague, you can expect up to four and a half hours of walking during the city tour with stops, and should be prepared for climbing up and down occasional steps and walking on uneven surfaces. The Prague Castle visit lasts approximately three hours and includes standing for longer periods of time. If you have chosen the classic Budapest city tour option as your selected choice on tour, it will include up to three and a half hours of walking.

This is a winter program, and you can expect surfaces covered with frost, snow, or ice.

Most of the cities on this program are very busy with visitors during Advent.

The longest day will require a departure from the Vienna hotel at 8:00 a.m. for your train to Bratislava. In Bratislava, you will continue traveling by coach, arriving at the Budapest hotel after 7:00 p.m.

This tour features multiple long transfers exceeding two hours, in particular the transfer to and from Dresden, Germany. The transfer from Prague to Vienna, Austria, with stops in between, can take up to 10 hours.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Single rate subject to change based on availability.

Not all major sites can be reached by coach. Public transportation might be used during the Budapest city tour.

To complete your tour, we include round-trip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of purchasing these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

For air-inclusive reservations, the name provided at time of booking must match your government-issued ID that will be used during travel. Name changes are subject to penalties.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

Travel Requirements:

Passports are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require that your passport be valid at least 6 months beyond the dates of your travel. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for
