A reading from the first Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. To one is given through the Spirit the expression of wisdom; to another the expression of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit; to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit; to another mighty deeds; to another prophecy; to another discernment of spirits; to another varieties of tongues; to another interpretation of tongues.

But one and the same Spirit produces all of these, distributing them individually to each person as he wishes. As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ.

For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.



THE SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

The Prime Bishop intones the first phrase of "Come, Thou Creator"



The Prime Bishop, facing the confirmands, says:

Dear brother and sisters:

Some time ago you were admitted to the Holy Catholic Church of Jesus Christ through Baptism. At that time, you made certain promises. Now I call upon you to confirm those commitments and publicly profess your faith in Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

We read in the Acts of the Apostles that on the day of Pentecost, the Apostles received the Holy Spirit and they were empowered to give that same Spirit to others, completing the work of baptism. The Prime Bishop, as the successor to the Apostles, posses the power of giving the Holy Spirit to the Baptized. This Spirit fills our hearts with love of God, strengthens our faith and works within us to enable us to spread the good news of Christ every day of our lives.

You must testify before the world to His suffering, death and resurrection. Your life should always reflect the goodness and love of Jesus and you must use the talents God has given you to bring others closer to our Lord.

You must remain faithful to His Holy Church through worship and dedication, serving others as Christ did, with the knowledge that He has prepared a place in heaven for those who follow Him.

And now, before you receive the Holy Spirit in this Sacrament, I ask you to confirm the profession of faith made at baptism.

RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

Presenter: Most Reverend Father in God, I present

Mahryna Faustina, Khloe Veronica, Tyler Christopher and Jessica Julia to receive the

Holy Sacrament of Confirmation.

Prime Bishop: Do you know that they are prepared and

worthy?

Presenter: Insofar as the grace of God allows, I do.

The Prime Bishop now asks the following questions of the candidates:

Prime Bishop: Do you reject all evil and evil works?

Candidates: I do.

Prime Bishop: Do you believe in God, the almighty Father?

Candidates: I believe in God the Father almighty, Creator of

heaven and earth.

Prime Bishop: Do you believe in Jesus Christ?

Candidates: I believe in Jesus Christ, God's only Son, our

Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended to the dead. On the third day He rose again, He ascended into heaven, He is seated at the right hand of the Father and He will come to

judge the living and the dead.

Prime Bishop: Do you believe in the Holy Spirit?

Candidates: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic

Church, the communion of saints, the

forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body

and life everlasting.

Prime Bishop: Do you now reaffirm your commitment to Jesus

Christ?

Candidates: I do, and with God's grace, I will follow Him as

my Lord and Savior.

Prime Bishop: Our Help is in the name of the Lord.

Response: Who made heaven and earth.

Prime Bishop: O Lord, hear our prayer.

Response: And let our cry come to you.

Prime Bishop: The Lord be with you.

Response: And also with you.

Prime Bishop: Let us pray. Almighty Father, through baptism

You have given your people new life, and granted them forgiveness of their sins. We know call upon You to send Your Holy spirit upon them with His sevenfold gifts: the Spirit of wisdom and understanding; the Spirit of counsel and fortitude; the Spirit of knowledge and piety. Fill them with the fear of the Lord.

We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ, our

Lord.

Response: Amen.

Prime Bishop: (name of candidate), I sign you with the sign of

the cross and seal you with the Chrism of Salvation, in the name of the Father, and of the

son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Confirmed: Amen.

Prime Bishop: Peace be with you.

Almighty God, You gave the Holy Spirit to Your Apostles and willed that through them and their successors He be given to the rest of the faithful. Look with favor on our service and grant that the Holy Spirit abiding in the hearts of those we have anointed with Chrism and signed with the holy Cross may, by dwelling in them cause them to become templates of His glory. We ask this in the name of Jesus Christ,

our Lord.

Response: Amen.

DECLARATION OF THE CONFIRMED

On this solemn day when I received the Sacrament of Confirmation, I publicly declare before Almighty God, and all here present that I shall be a faithful member of Christ's Holy Church.

Strengthened by the gifts of the Holy Spirit, I promise to do all in my power to live in accord with His Holy will, by a life built on faith and love.

I promise to worship faithfully and to fulfill the obligations imposed by my Christian Faith.

I promise to remember always and in all places, that I am a member of the Polish National Catholic Church and I will loyally fulfill my responsibilities to my church.

So help me God, one in the Blessed Trinity.

Amen.

The Mass now continues with the General Intercessions.



EUCHARISTIC PRAYER IV

The Dutch Old Catholic Canon

(during Easter season, STAND)

Blessed are You, Lord of all majesty and King of eternal glory through Your only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ.

In Him Your Word was made flesh. In Him the fullness of Your grace was revealed in splendor. In all things, He fulfilled Your will and glorified your name.

He proclaimed Your Kingdom to us. He broke the power of darkness over us. He took our guilt upon Himself. He reconciled us to You and unlocked the new paradise for us. As the Way, the Truth and the Life, he has revealed Your love to us.

He humbled Himself and became obedient even to death on a cross, and by rising restored our life.

On the night in which He was betrayed to undergo that suffering which He Himself had chosen, He took bread into His hands and, lifting His eyes to You His heavenly Father, He gave thanks. He blessed the bread, broke it and gave it to His disciples, saying:

Take this, all of you, and eat it

FOR THIS IS MY BODY WHICH IS GIVEN FOR YOU

(during Easter season, GENUFLECT)

When supper had ended, he took the cup and gave thanks to You. He blessed it, and gave it to His disciples, saying:

Take this all of you and drink from it:

FOR THIS IS THE CUP OF MY BLOOD; THE BLOOD OF THE NEW AND EVERLASTING COVENANT, WHICH SHALL BE SHED FOR YOU AND FOR MANY FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS.

As often as you do this, do it in remembrance of me.

(during Easter season, GENUFLECT)

Your death, Lord Jesus, we proclaim! Your resurrection we celebrate! Your return in glory we await!

Therefore, Father, we remember His saving Passion, His glorious Resurrection and His Exaltation at Your right hand. We await His coming in the fullness of majesty. We here set forth this sign of our faith in Him Who offered You the perfect sacrifice and gained for us eternal salvation.

Send Your Holy Spirit, the giver of life and holiness, upon us and upon these Gifts; the Bread and Wine of eternal life.

Holy Spirit come to us. Fill us with Your gift of grace.

Take these Gifts from our hands, Lord God, as an acceptable sacrifice through which we offer ourselves to You so that the

Bread which we break and the Cup which we bless may be sharing in the Body and Blood of Your Son.

May all who receive from Your heavenly altar always remain united with You, together with all Your saints and chosen ones; with the blessed and glorious Virgin Mary, the Mother of our Lord, with Your prophets and apostles, with Your martyrs and confessors and with all who stand about Your throne in praise and prayer.


Grant also, Lord, a share in that glory to the departed and to those whom we remember before You.

Through Him, with Him, in Him, in the unity of the Holy spirit, all honor and glory is Yours, almighty Father, for ever and ever.





C: The peace of the Lord be with you always.






