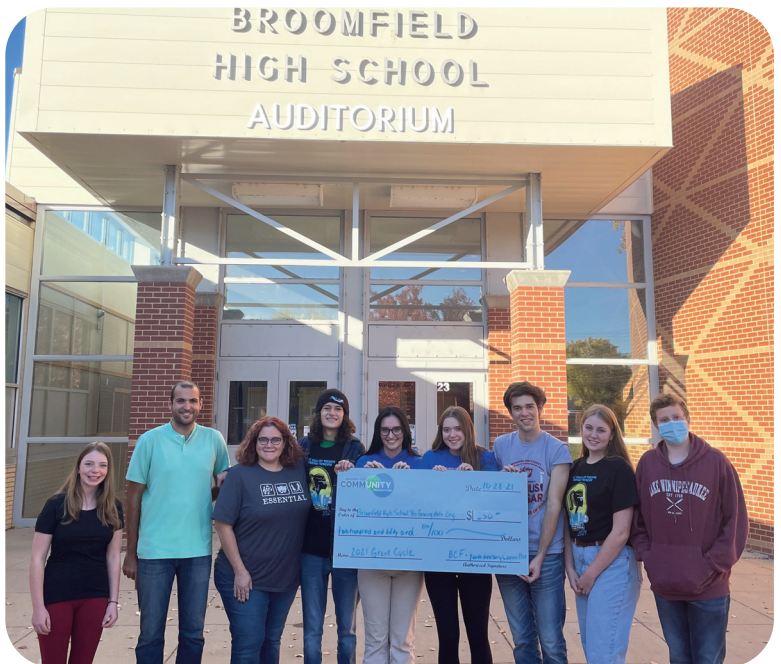
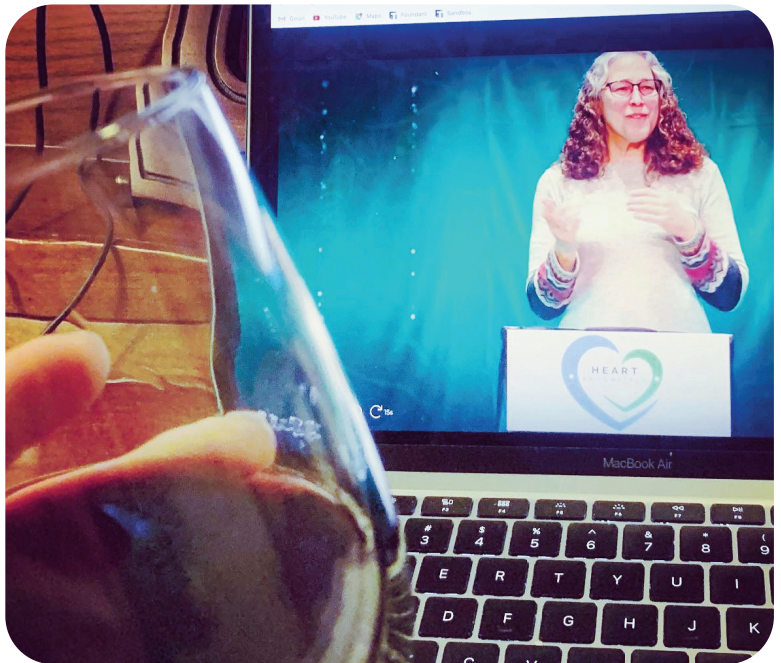

We at the Broomfield Community Foundation strive to be a voice and resource for the many needs of our friends and neighbors in the Broomfield Community. Thanks to you - our partners, donors, and volunteers, we have been able to enhance the lives of so many in the place we all call home. **If anything has become abundantly clear over the last few years, it is that the only thing we can count on is Change.** Currently, it seems that every aspect of our organization is facing new and changing landscapes. Here at the Foundation, we have adapted by working closely with our partners, building our capacity as an organization, and seeking opportunities for collaborative community involvement. We are dedicated to using our resources and working with our local nonprofits, corporate partners, and local government in Broomfield to address some of the biggest challenges facing our community, such as mental health, addiction, and affordable housing, which directly and tangentially affect our community as a whole.

In these efforts, the Foundation facilitated a total of \$311,902 in grants and scholarships last year, focused on our five pillars: Human Services, Education, Seniors, Arts, and Civic initiatives. In addition to providing valuable grant funding, we created an Afghan Evacuee Resettlement Fund for recent local evacuees, and we continue our involvement hosting the Broomfield Community Service Network (BCSN), our annual Volunteer Match, as well as 6 Knowledge Series events. We have also spearheaded a new Business Impact Partner program. As we reflect, it becomes clear that we could not have made an impact without all of us working together. We sincerely thank the Foundation's board, staff, and the tireless work of our community partners and nonprofits as we all weather this season of change.

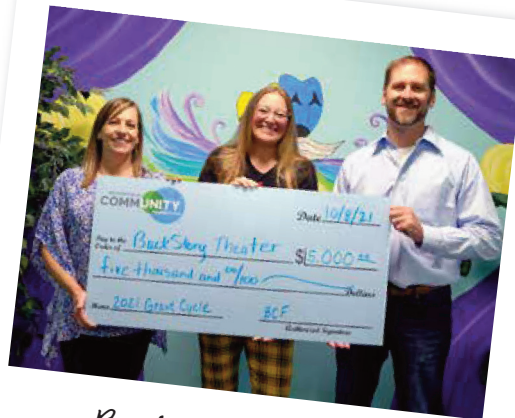

RMLC

Rocky Mountain Legal Center has a primary mission of providing free and low cost legal services to people who could not otherwise afford an attorney. Through our collaborative relationship with the Broomfield Senior Center and because of the funding we have received from BCF, we created a program which provides low cost estate planning and asset protection services to Broomfield residents. In the last two years and through the grant from BCF, we have provided legal services to over 100 Broomfield residents and we now assist an average of 10 residents per month. We expect to see a 25% increase in the number of Broomfield residents served in 2022.

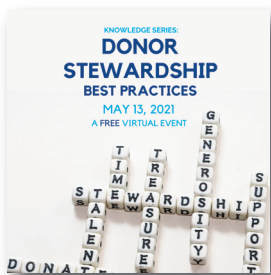
