TREASURER'S REPORT

For the year to date to June 30, our deficit (we've spent more than we have received) has reached \$13,416. We do have funds built up in our general account from previous years to cover this deficit, and this deficit has been anticipated. During the month of June, there were two large expenditures. We have paid \$5,969 towards the parking lot lighting project and the first of three \$2,763 installments towards the insurance.
