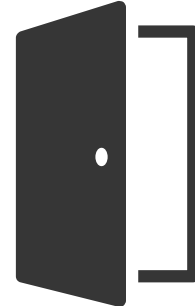

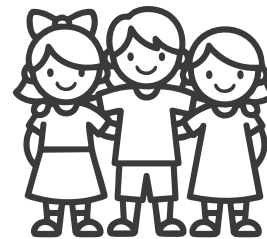

Boys & Girls Clubs of the Cedar Valley continues to find ways to engage with club members. We currently have three stand-alone sites and one school-based site.

## Lime Street Club

- 629 Registered Club members
- 72% of youth felt a sense of belonging at the club
- 71% of kids reported being able to try new things at the club

## Elk Run Club

- 144 Registered Club members
- 74% of kids report feeling physically safe inside the club
- 87% of kids feel they have at least 1 supportive adult connection in the club

## Teen & Educational Center

- 238 Registered Club members
- 83% of kids report they are on track for graduation
- 87% of students have a plan for after high school graduation

## Lincoln Elementary

- 133 Registered Club members
- 69% of kids demonstrated improvement in reading and language arts skills
- 74% of kids showed gains in math proficiency
