Dear Parents and Carers,

I shared last week the new guidance regarding the wearing of face coverings in school. https://www.gov.uk/government/news/face-coverings-no-longer-required-in-schools-and-colleges-from-17-may

Whilst the guidance has changed regarding the wearing of face coverings for students, it is important that families continue with their twice weekly COVID testing routine and that we all prioritise handwashing and social distancing, to keep everyone safe. I also understand that several students and staff will continue to wear a face covering for the additional protection and confidence it provides.

I wrote to all parents and carers on the 9th and 22nd February 2021, to share a proposal for a new structure of the school day. I had several positive e-mails and three that highlighted separate concerns regarding; accessing public transport, the length of lessons and length of break times. Thank you to those parents and carers who took time to share their thoughts. In response, I would like to confirm;

- All students will be able to access public transport using the current bus timetables. We will
 also be making available the learning resource areas on both sites before and after school
 finishes, to enable all students to complete homework / additional study, or wait for school
 to start / transport home at a later time.
- As I've highlighted before the new canteen on the Nevill campus and extension to the dining hall on the Valley campus, will mean we are able to reduce queueing for access to the canteen, at both break and lunchtime. With only a maximum of 2 year groups (as opposed to three in the current model), this will ensure all students are able to access the canteen and have time for a break.
- In addition to normal timetabled lessons, our 'Every Child Should Strategy' sets out our aim to ensure all students take advantage of the opportunities for enrichment and extracurricular activities. There will be an extensive after school provision that we will be strongly encouraging all students to take part in, at least once a week. Any additional targeted learning either as part of the school's provision or through the government funded tuition programme, will be scheduled at the end of the school day.

In summary, the feedback from staff, students, parents and carers to the proposal has been overwhelmingly positive and I have confirmed with the governing body that we will be moving


