Cookies are small text files which a website may put on your computer or mobile device when you first visit the website. We use cookies to distinguish you from other users of the website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you use the website and also allows us to improve the services we provide to you.

Types of Cookies We Use

We use the following cookies:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

These are cookies that are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website. Disabling them may mean you are not able to access parts of our website.

Analytical or Performance Cookies

We use these cookies to collect information about how visitors use the website, for instance, which pages visitors go to most. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. Some of these cookies are known as analytic cookies which allow us to monitor website traffic using industry accepted third parties.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies are used to recognise you when you return to our website and to remember changes you have made to things such as text size, fonts and other parts of the website you can change so we can personalise our content for you.

Managing Your Cookie Preferences

Most browsers accept cookies automatically, but you can change your cookie preferences by adjusting your browser settings to refuse the setting of all or some cookies if you prefer. You can usually do this by visiting the 'options' or 'preferences' menu on your browser.

Please note, however, that if you do this and choose to block all cookies (including essential cookies), we cannot guarantee that your experience will be as fulfilling as it would otherwise be, and you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.

Session Cookie _session_id	Strictly Necessary	Keeps you logged in and maintains your session as you navigate between pages.	Expires when the browser is closed (session cookie)
Cookie Consent cookieConsent	Strictly Necessary	Stores your cookie preferences so you are not asked again on subsequent visits.	1 year
Google Analytics _ga	Analytical / Performance	Used by Google Analytics to distinguish users and track website usage statistics.	2 years
Google Analytics _gid	Analytical / Performance	Used by Google Analytics to distinguish users.	24 hours
Preferences user_prefs	Functionality	Remembers your preferences such as text size and layout choices so the website can personalise content for you on return visits.	1 year
