PRIVATE PILOT LICENSE (PPL)

Your gateway to aviation. Learn to fly single-engine aircraft under visual conditions (VFR), with foundational skills in navigation, communication, and emergency response.

INSTRUMENT RATING (IR)

Expand your capabilities with advanced weather theory, instrument navigation, and low-visibility procedures. This rating follows PPL to ensure you're confident in basic flight before relying solely on instruments.



COMMERCIAL PILOT LICENSE (CPL)

Fly for hire with enhanced precision. Master complex maneuvers, advanced aircraft systems, and flight planning to meet professional standards.

COMMERCIAL MULTI-ENGINE ADD-ON (CAMEL)

Train in multi-engine aircraft, focusing on engine-out procedures, asymmetric thrust, and performance differences. Adds depth to your commercial privileges.



CERTIFIED FLIGHT INSTRUCTOR (CFI)

Learn to teach. Gain instructional techniques, briefing skills, and leadership training to guide new pilots and build flight hours.

INSTRUMENT INSTRUCTOR (CFI-I)

Teach IFR skills, approaches, and decision-making in instrument conditions. Sharpen your own understanding while preparing others for safe cloud-based operations.



MULTI-ENGINE INSTRUCTOR (MEI)

Guide students in twin-engine aircraft with emphasis on emergency scenarios, system coordination, and aerodynamic complexities.

Certified Flight Instructor - Instrument (CFI-I)	18	CFI + IR	2nd Class Medical
Multi-Engine Instructor (MEI)	18	CFI + CAMEL	No written test; 2nd Class Medical
