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BSC CORE VALUES IN ACTION

EDUCATE

We educate the families about the challenges that deaf and hard of hearing children face.

- Reached 174 families this year in 22 counties
- Partnered with **SC Hands & Voices** to host **7** Topic Tuesday webinars for parents and professionals.
- Hosted a Virtual Author Night.

ADVOCATE

Together with the family, we assemble and support both short and long term game plans that increase the opportunities for both the child and family.

- Received **43** new family referrals.
- Advocated with parents at 13 IEP meetings and pre-IEP preparation meetings.
- Provided 2,431 minutes of consultation to professionals and partner organizations, helping ensure families received personalized, expert support.
- Facilitated 15 Preschool Transition Meetings

FACILITATE

We connect and facilitate the professional resources required to maximize the successful belonging of both the child and the family.

- 1,498 of South Carolina's children received hearing screenings in 33 child care programs across the state totaling 11,756 children having been screened since the program's inception.
- Referred **37** families to partner organizations for additional support and services.
- Grew our online community through increased engagement and number of followers on our social media.
- **1,230** minutes participating in Task Forces, Coalitions, and Committee Meetings to improve outcomes for children across the state.
