Progreso Independent School District (ISD) hereby provides public notice of its intent to apply for funding through the Texas ACE 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) Grant – Cycle 13, in accordance with requirements established by the Texas Education Agency (TEA).

The Texas ACE 21st CCLC program supports the establishment of community learning centers that provide academic enrichment opportunities during non-school hours for students, particularly those attending Title I and high-poverty campuses.

Program Overview:

The proposed program will:

- Provide afterschool and summer learning opportunities
- Support academic enrichment, positive youth development, and family engagement
- Prioritize services for students attending Title I and high-poverty campuses

If awarded, Progreso ISD will collaborate with campus staff and community partners to implement safe, engaging, and developmentally appropriate programming that supports student achievement and well-being beyond the traditional school day.
