**The Vocation of the Christian**

*The first reading and Gospel are linked to each other by the theme of God's choice of a people consecrated to him.*

*In the Old Testament this choice fell on the twelve tribes of Israel and in the New Testament on the twelve apostles, God's people, both in the Old and in the New Testament, is called to holiness, that is, to a type of life completely different from the others. This life is to become a sign of salvation for all men. The gospel describes this "holy" life of the disciples of Christ: a life full of deeds of charity and works of love for their brothers and sisters.*

*The second reading links up to this theme since it speaks of the gratuitousness of love of God, a gift that the disciples of Christ must learn to appreciate and propagate in their lives.*
