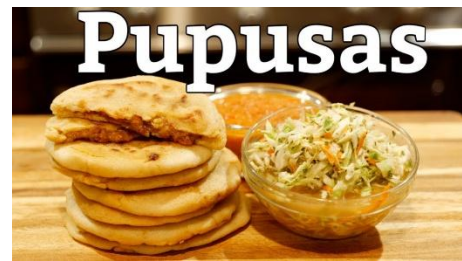

SUNDAY REFLEXION



THE ONE WHO HEALS THE LEPERS IS NOW AMONG US

Why do we take pride in the good deeds we do? Why do we feel superior and grater than the others and despise them? Because we forget that we are lepers who have been healed by the word of Jesus. The gospel tells us that the first to understand this truth were those that the Jews considered heretics.

The first reading also shows us a leper, Naaman, who was even a foreigner. He is healed in the body and in the spirit by his encounter with the man sent by God.

The second reading gives us the example of Paul. He was well aware that he had been a 'leper'. Christ had saved him and had enabled him to bear everything for the sake of the gospel.
