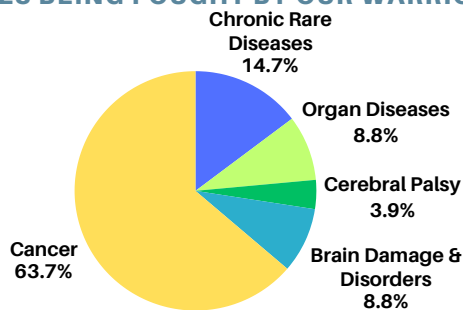

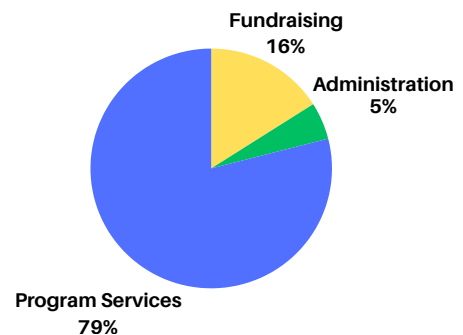

#### WHO WE ASSIST

- 39% of families fall below the national poverty line
- 76% of children have married parents
- 24% of families are a single-parent household
- 1,890 children & families helped locally
- 200 new families assisted nationally during the fiscal year
- 51% BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color) families
- Trusted Partner for Children's Hospitals and Social Workers

#### YOUTH LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

- Training 9th-12th grade students in servant leadership and community engagement.
- Over 50 high school students participate annually from 8 different schools.
