We are deeply grateful to our donors, whose support has allowed us to reach more children and families across the United States. We are also excited to announce that we now have a new office, which will serve as a hub for our continued development.

We are pleased to introduce "Triumph Together," a new program under the Mitchell Thorp Foundation (MTF) brand. Jack Gates has joined us as the Director of Philanthropy, responsible for overseeing this program along with our marketing and events. We encourage you to explore all our programs to see the impact we are making.

To enhance our support for families, we have partnered with Explore Counseling Group (ECG) to expand our Healing and Rehabilitation program. ECG will provide Individual, Family, and Couples Counseling, including Cognitive Behavioral Therapy, Mindfulness-Based Therapy, Trauma-Informed Care, Grief Counseling, and Emotionally Focused Therapy.

Families dealing with a life-threatening diagnosis for their child often experience increased anxiety and depression. This situation frequently leads to one parent becoming a full-time caregiver, resulting in emotional strain and financial hardship due to loss of income. The challenges and 24/7 care demands can disrupt the entire family's life.

We recognize that illness affects people regardless of age, gender, lifestyle, or background. The resilience and determination of our Mitchell Thorp Foundation families and children are truly inspiring. They continue to face significant obstacles with strength and find reasons to smile despite their struggles.

At the Mitchell Thorp Foundation, our mission is to make a difference today for children fighting for their tomorrow, while providing hope, relief, and transformation. OUR MISSION

Supporting families whose children are suffering from life-threatening illness, diseases, and disorders by providing financial, emotional, and resource support to their desperate situations.

OUR CHALLENGE

- LOSS OF INCOME:
- Typically, one parent has to quit their job to stay by their child's bedside to care for them full-time.
- FINANCIAL BURDEN:

 Parents struggle to keep up with medical bills and household expenses.

EMOTIONAL STRESS:

78% of families whose child is diagnosed with a critical illness experience divorce or separation. The stress will test families beyond their endurance, bankrupting them financially, emotionally, and physically.

OUR PURPOSE

Mitchell Thorp Foundation's purpose is to make a difference **today** for a child fighting for their **tomorrow** by bringing hope, relief, and essential resources and services to children and their families.





MEDICAL & HOME ASSISTANCE

- Provides financial support for required medical treatments and equipment that are not covered by insurance.
- Transportation Services: Provide funding for airfare, gas, and hotel stays.
- Home assistance, utility bills, food, etc.

HEALING & REHABILITATION

- Physical Therapy Services beyond treatment.
- Counseling Services for affected child and family.
- Sibling Support- School tutors, and camps for the affected child and sibling.

WHEELCHAIR CONVERSION VAN

- Assists families with conversions and wheelchair accessible vehicles, affording them the freedom to enjoy their time together for as long as that may be.
- A handicap accessible mobility van is a necessity, not a luxury.



YOUTH LEADERSHIP COUNCIL

The Mitchell Thorp Foundation is dedicated to nurturing and inspiring the next generation of leaders within our community through its Youth Leadership Council program. This initiative brings together high school students from North San Diego County to engage in meaningful leadership experiences.

PRIMARY FOCUS



Leadership Development: Cultivating essential leadership skills and strategies.

Individual Growth: Supporting personal development and self-improvement.

OBJECTIVE: To help students build leadership skills and make a meaningful impact in their community.

Through these experiences, the Youth Leadership Council aims to equip students with the tools to lead effectively and contribute positively to their communities.




TRIUMPH TOGETHER





ETHNICITY DEMOGRAPHIC




OUR IMPACT




ANEW CREATION BY BETH THORP




