
## Write A Letter To The Ancestors -or - A Letter To Future Generations



**Step 1.** Everyone of all ages are welcome to write:  
Please choose just one (1) letter to write:

(a) A Letter to the "ANCESTORS" at the historic Pine Street African Burial Ground -or -

(b) A Letter to "FUTURE GENERATIONS"



**Step 2.** Only handwritten letters are accepted

Write your heartfelt handwritten letter, starting with: "Dear Ancestors" or "Dear Future Generations." Use one sheet of paper, both sides if needed. Write clearly, as letters cannot be rewritten after submission. Helping someone with a hand-written letter is great!



**Step 3**

Sign your letter with your full name or first name only or your initial. Also include the current date, your city, and state at the bottom of your letter. Your school/class name, organization or family name can be added.



**Step 4**

Place your completed letter in an **unsealed envelope** addressed it to: **Harambee Kingston - Pine Street African Burial Ground, 157 Pine Street, Kingston, NY.**

**Last Step**

Submit your letter for inclusion in the **Memorial Monument - Time Capsule by May 31<sup>st</sup>**. You can drop off your Letter at Harambee, at designated locations or mail it to: **Harambee Kingston - Pine Street African Burial Ground**. Selected letters will be read at the **Juneteenth Ceremony on June 19, 2026**.
