15 Most Frequently Asked Questions about Broken Bow.

1. Does Broken Bow have a Farmer's Market?

Yes! *Market on the Square* takes place on Thursdays from early June through the end of September, 10 a.m.–4 p.m., along the east side of our historic downtown Square. <u>Learn</u> more on Facebook.

2. Is there a grocery store?

Yes! We have **Grocery Kart** (937 East South E St.) plus two Dollar Generals conveniently located on Highway 2, both east and west of town.

3. What youth activities are available?

Plenty! From 4-H clubs and church groups to gymnastics, dance, and youth sports through <u>Custer County Youth Sports</u>. Broken Bow Public Schools also offers a wide range of clubs, fine arts, and athletic programs.

4. What outdoor recreation is available?

We're an active community! Enjoy softball, sand volleyball, baseball, football, soccer, golf, swim team, and more. Melham Park offers a fishing pond, walking/biking trail, and a disc golf course. For something unique, visit the **Nebraska One Box Gun Club** for shooting sports and events.

5. Does Broken Bow have a dog park?

Not exactly—but dogs are welcome in all parks as long as they're leashed and licensed.

6. Are there dog breed restrictions?

Nope! All breeds are welcome in Broken Bow. Just remember to license your pup. More details are available on the <u>Broken Bow Police website</u>.

7. Where can I find veterinary care?

8. Is there a movie theater?

Yes! The Fox Theater offers three screens with great movie selections.

10. Are there car washes?

Yes, two—both located on Highway 2. For professional detailing, contact **Auto Dealer Solutions** (219 S C St., 308-872-0093).

11. Does Broken Bow have a library?

Yes—the **Broken Bow Public Library** was recently renovated and offers conference rooms, study spaces, and a wide selection of books. Digital options include eBooks, eAudiobooks, and eMagazines. The library also has amazing children's programs! <u>Visit their</u> website.

12. Is there a dry cleaner?

While we don't have a full-service dry cleaner in town, **Lillie Kate Boutique** (on the Square) offers a convenient drop-off service. Your items will be sent to Ideal Cleaners in Grand Island.

13. Is there a laundromat?

Yes—located at 312 South 7th Ave.

14. Does Broken Bow have a fair or a rodeo?

Yes and yes! The **Custer County Fairgrounds** hosts many events each year, including the DC Lynch Carnival in July and the **Custer County Fair** at the end of July. Rodeo fans will also love the roping, barrel racing, and other competitions. <u>Learn more</u>.

15. What kind of medical care is available?

Broken Bow is home to two clinics—**Central Nebraska Medical Clinic** and **Click Family Healthcare**—as well as a 23-bed critical access hospital. The hospital features a modern ER, radiology services, and a Specialty Clinic with providers in cardiology, orthopedics, OB/GYN, oncology, urology, pulmonology, and more.
