Price for a vendor space is based on use, what is sold, and amount of space needed. The following will explain the vendor pricing so please read carefully:

\_\_\_ **Arts/Crafts/Products Vendors** selling items besides food/taking orders  
 - per 12x12 space . . . \$125.00 If two spaces are needed, cost is \$225.00.

\_\_\_ **Vendors Selling Food/Snacks** prepackaged or fixed on site such as kettle corn, cotton candy, frozen dessert, lemonade, etc. – per 12’x12’ space.... \$150.00 If two spaces are needed, cost is \$275.00 (The length of the trailer or vehicle that needs to be left in place will determine the cost of the area and location placement. Contact Doyle Keasal at the email/phone listed for pricing.)

\_\_\_ **Food Vendor** - Individual or Company selling food fixed on site with grill, cooktop, or other cooking device - per 12x12 space -\$225.00, 12’x24’ space - \$425.00 or \$500.00 if a larger space is needed up to 36’. If an even larger space is needed, contact Doyle Keasal at the email/phone number listed at the end of the application form.

- \* If using a food truck or trailer, measure its total length when setup so that we can assign the proper length space. The length of my food trailer/truck is \_\_\_\_\_.
- \*\*All food vendors will be placed in a vendor location at the discretion of our staff since we have to make sure they do not block the flow of traffic and can get in and out of the location.
- \*\*\*If you are working from a trailer or truck, please plan on setting up on Friday, Oct. 30 as it is very difficult to set up once the other vendors are in place. If you are not able to set up until Saturday, please let me know as this will determine location.

\_\_\_ **Political/Information Booths** (NOT SELLING or TAKING ORDERS) - per 12 x 12 space-\$50.00

- \*Food vendors are required to mail a copy of food service license with application so that we have it on file.
- \*\*\$25 dollars of each rental selling goods or food goes to the Town of Loachapoka as a one-day business license.
- \*\*\* Vendor fee is non-refundable after October 1, 2026 (minus \$10 processing fee). Refunds will not be given due to weather.

We have limited electrical hookups and water connections. The access points for both of these are shown on the maps. If you need either, please check the one(s) below that you need and include the fee with your application fee. The type of connection you need will also determine which vendor spaces are available for you. Participant is responsible for supplying water hose or electrical cords. Generators are allowed as long as they are not too loud or cause problems with your neighboring vendors.

Vendor fees are payable on line: [www.leecountyhistoricalsociety.org](http://www.leecountyhistoricalsociety.org) starting April 15, 2026.

We will allow past vendors to reserve the same location as last year up until May 18. Beginning on May 19, I will reserve spaces on a first-paid, first-reserved basis. Therefore, when making a location request (both past and first-time vendors), list your top three choices and I will try to honor one of them. If all three locations are taken, I will assign you the next best space. 1<sup>st</sup> Choice \_\_\_\_\_; 2<sup>nd</sup> \_\_\_\_\_; 3<sup>rd</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (Refer to the maps sent with this form or the maps on the website as some space numbers may change from one year to the next.)

For clarification, changes are made each year to the vendor site maps as we continue to work on improving the Syrup Sopping Day experience for vendors and attendees. See map (posted on April 15) on website ([www.leecountyhistoricalsociety.org](http://www.leecountyhistoricalsociety.org)) as you will need to list your vendor space preferences above. **Vendor locations are not reserved until payment is made.**

Changing of vendor spaces and selection of vendor locations will be at the discretion of the Vendor Director (Doyle Keasal). Notification of receipt of payment and location of vendor assignment will be done by email. Those without email will receive a mailed notification.

No live animals are to be sold or given away with purchases (lizards, turtles, frogs, etc.). Artisan/craftsman, food vendors and all others, include a brief description of what you sell below or on the back of this form.
