When to refer a patient?

As the treating doctor, you are in the best position to determine if your patient needs additional support. We recommend our services when a patient is:

- Feeling Vulnerable or concerned with their return to work

- You need more information, workplace modifications or changes to the workplace to progress or confirm a return to work plan
