JOB DESCRIPTION

- 7. Plan and conduct the worship services; prepare and deliver sermons; and lead in the observances of the ordinances of the Lord's Supper and baptism. John 21:15 17
- 8. Conduct counseling sessions; perform wedding ceremonies; conduct funerals. Acts 20:28
- 9. Work with the deacons, church officers, and committees as they perform their assigned duties; train and lead the deacons in a program of family ministries. Ephesians 4:2 3
- 10. Cooperate with associational, state and national denominational leaders in matters of mutual interest. Hebrews 13:1
- 11. Serve as church moderator. Romans 15:6
