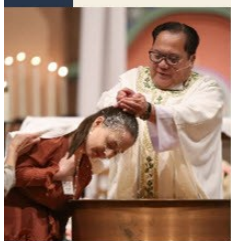

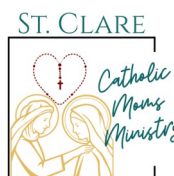

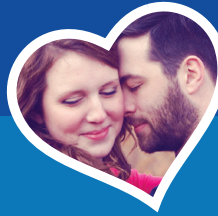

You are invited to join the *Arise* Catholic Men's Ministry



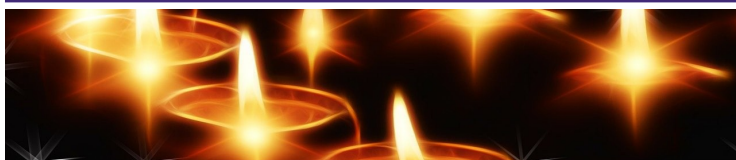
