9th Annual Mount Saint Joseph Wines Blessing of the Vineyard

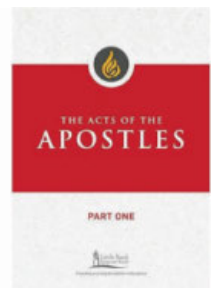
