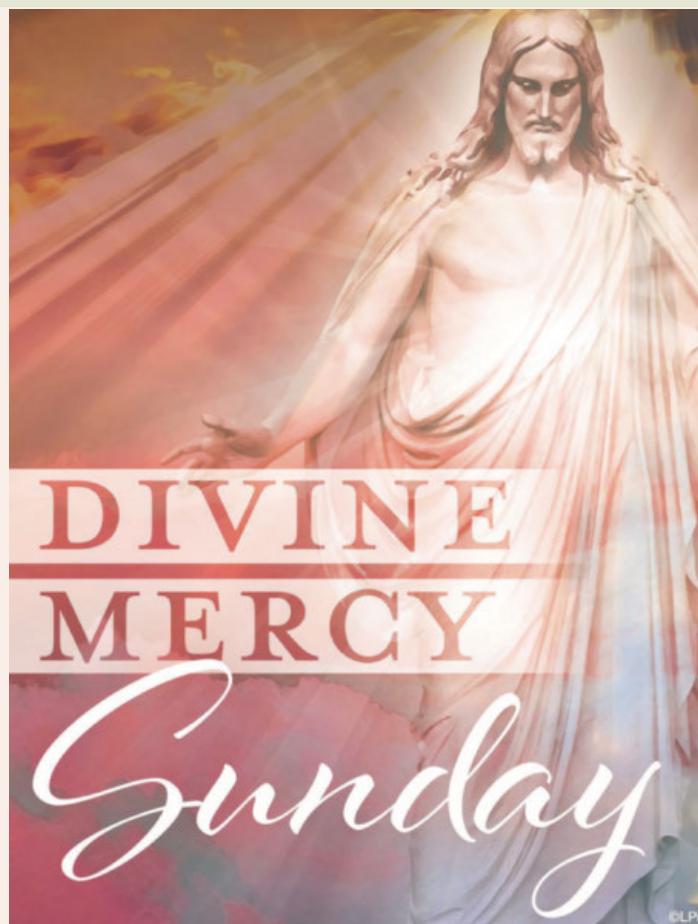

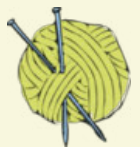

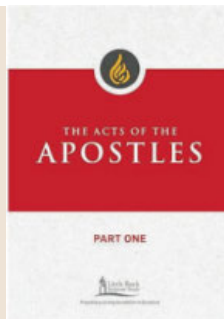
St. Clare Bible Study Starting April 10

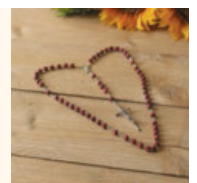

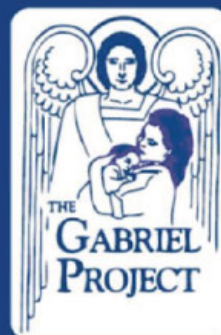
