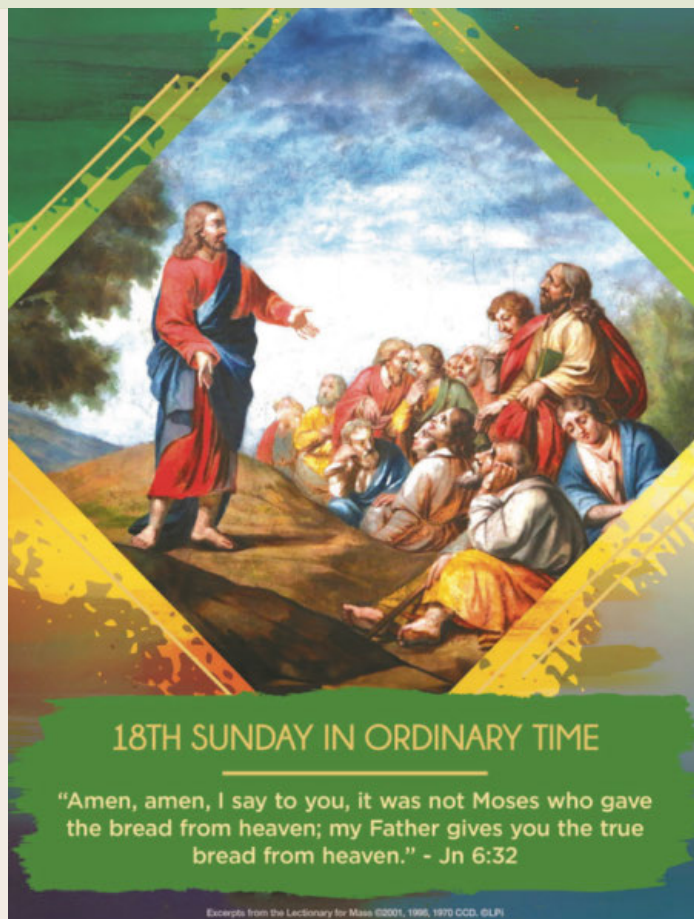

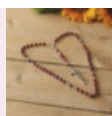

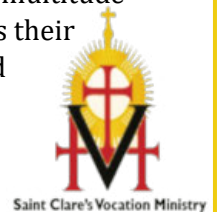


Would you like to make sense of your suffering? Would you like to deepen your personal relationship with the living Christ? Would you be interested in learning to read and meditate the Bible?

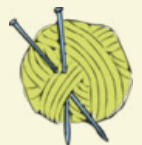

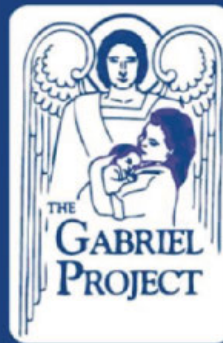
