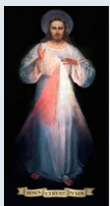

"Man does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God." (Matthew 4:4)

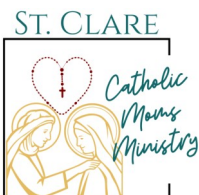

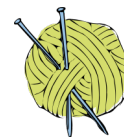

WHY IS A CAPITAL CAMPAIGN DIFFERENT?



Giving to the Catholic Church—through the weekly offertory, diocesan appeals, and capital campaigns—is an act of stewardship and gratitude.

Why is a Capital Campaign different than a Diocesan Appeal?

A capital campaign is a multi-year, high-intensity effort aimed at funding specific, large-scale projects (like a new building or renovation) that are beyond a normal operating budget.

A diocesan appeal is an annual, ongoing appeal covering yearly operational, administrative, or pastoral costs.

Why is a Capital Campaign different than the Offertory?

The offertory is the regular, recurring Sunday collection that funds daily operations, ministries, and salaries.

A capital campaign is a temporary, focused effort to raise significant funds for specific, long-term investments (like building, expansion, or debt reduction).
