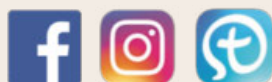

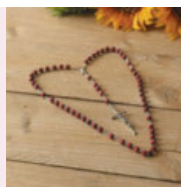

Anointing of the Sick and Blessing of Medical Professionals and Caregivers February 11

Our Lady of Lourdes and the World Day of the Sick will be celebrated after the 8:30am Mass on February 11 by offering the Anointing of the Sick. Parishioners who receive the sacrament should meet the criteria for Anointing shown below. Our clergy will also confer a blessing on medical professionals and caregivers who care for the sick.

Who may receive the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick?
We welcome any baptized Catholic who:

- Is dangerously ill through sickness or old age.
- Is sick or facing surgery.
- Is elderly and suffering weakness, though not necessarily dangerously ill.
- Is a sick child (at least aged 7) and sufficiently mature to be comforted by the sacrament.
- Has not already received the sacrament for the same illness if their condition remains the same.
