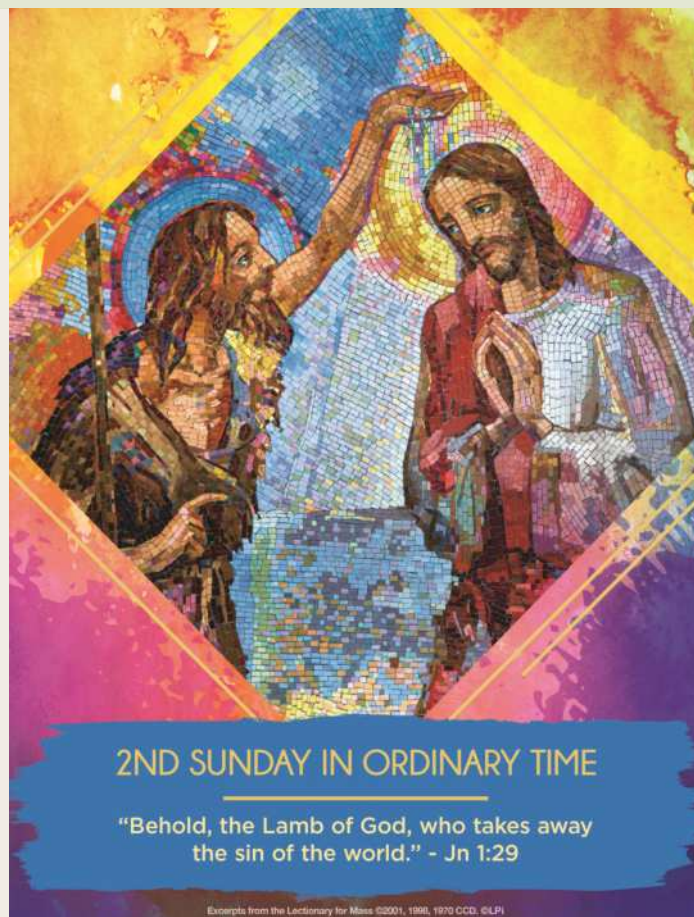

The Ukrainian families will once again be taking men's, women's and kids' clothing so we will be happy to take them again.

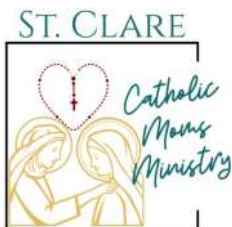
