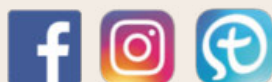

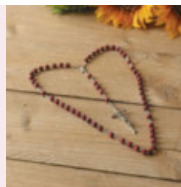

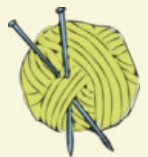

Monday, February 3, is the Memorial of St. Blaise. There will be a blessing of throats at the 8:30am Mass that day.

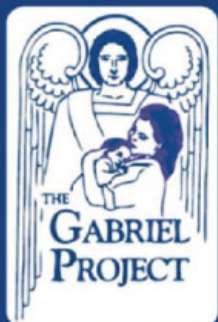
*St. Blaise was known for healing the sick and protecting those with ailments of the throat.
