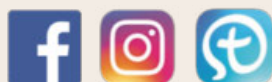

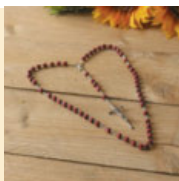

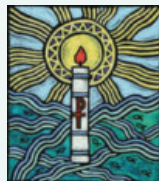

Thank you to all of you who have donated money through the Treasure Chest envelopes to help fund all that we do. May our Lord bless you all abundantly!!

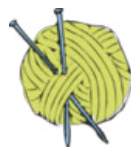


Grief, Consolation, and Hope Ministry

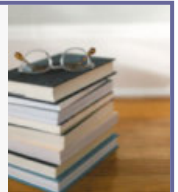
