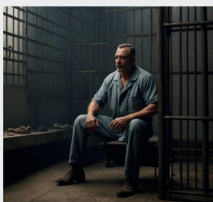
MEMORIAL OF OUR LADY OF MOUNT CARMEL

In the year 1251, Our Lady appeared to St. Simon Stock, a Carmelite. In time, the Church extended this magnificent privilege to all the laity who are willing to be invested in the Brown Scapular of the Carmelites and who perpetually wear it.



Come join us as we celebrate Our Lady's feast day at the 8:30am Mass on Thursday, July 16. There will be an enrollment and investiture of the Brown Scapular after the Mass. Scapulars will be provided. Enrollment in the Brown Scapular Confraternity is a one-time rite. You may request for a replacement scapular if needed.

VOLUNTEER JAIL CHAPLAINS



The Social Concerns ministry is currently recruiting seven additional volunteer Chaplains for Roseville Jail, Santucci Justice Center. This is a jail, not a prison, and we serve minimum security inmates. Candidates must be over 21 and be able to pass fingerprinting. We provide training and support.

Chaplains typically serve an hour and a half session, 9:00am-10:30am on Saturdays or Sundays. When we are fully staffed, chaplains serve as little as twelve sessions per year.
