This weekend, the second collection for the St. Clare Facility Maintenance Fund will take place. Your generous gift helps to keep our St. Clare Parish beautiful and functional.

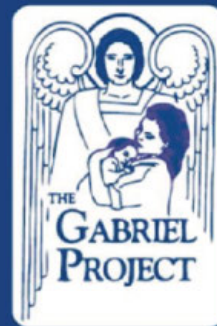
