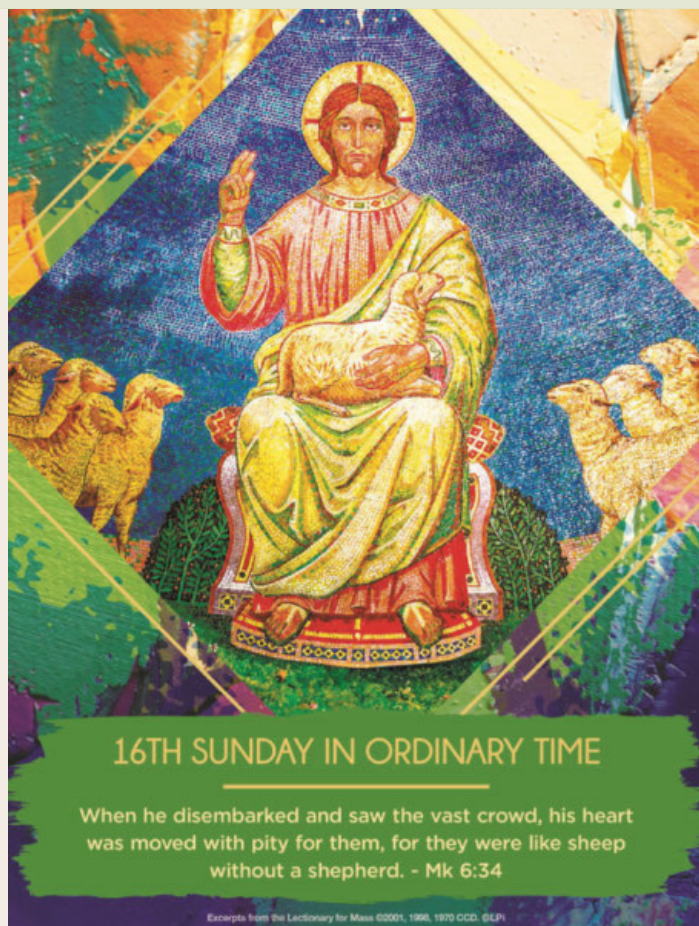

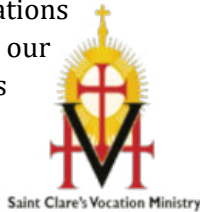


We are deeply grateful for your generous donations of wheelchairs and walkers. Your donations enabled us to ship seven wheelchairs and nine walkers to Kenya!

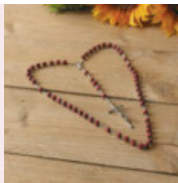

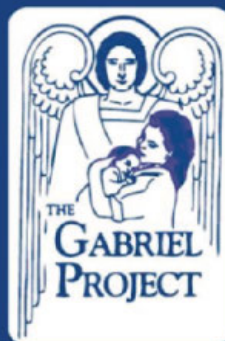
