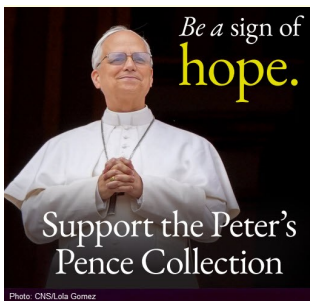

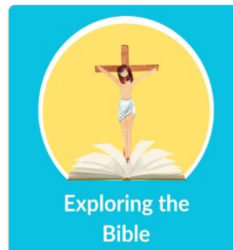


Part-Time Front Desk Receptionist

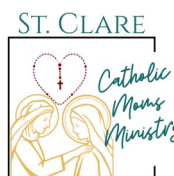

In Lincoln, a recent graduate of Phoenix High School began attending Sierra College. She was able to secure a dorm room through someone from the school, but she did not have the means to furnish it. Through your generosity, we were able to provide the essential items needed to make her new space a home.

In South Sacramento, the Missionaries of Charity Sisters were in need of a new security fence, as individuals had been climbing over their existing 5-foot chain link fence and staying on the property.
