Thank you to all who brought in canned ravioli and high protein energy bars last month. That was a huge help filling up our high school program pantry. This month we are asking for men's shorts and T-shirts. It is warming up and when we go out 10 times per month, our inventory goes fast!!



This last month we gave out 10 carloads and 9 truckloads of clothing, shoes, blankets, sleeping bags, tents, and furniture!! When we distribute clothing, shoes, and toys to the Ukrainian refugees, any leftover or unused items are trucked to various locations in Mexico every 6 to 12 weeks. These communities are notified of the upcoming visits and often there will be 300-400 people that receive clothing!!

ICF Dinner Meeting

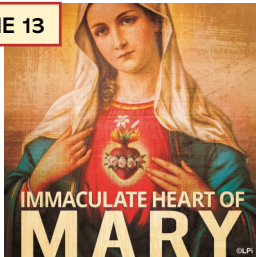
