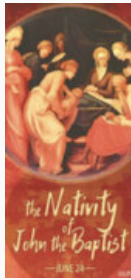

### Upcoming Solemnities this Week

Come celebrate these special feast days by attending the 8:30am Mass.

#### June 24 - The Nativity of St John the Baptist

Did you know only three birthdays are celebrated on the Church's liturgical calendar? The Nativity of Our Lord (December 25), the Nativity of His Mother (September 8), and the Nativity of His forerunner, John the Baptist, on June 24. Saint John the Baptist was set apart from the womb to prepare the way of the Lord and was a significant figure connected to the Incarnation and the Redemption. The Church honors him because of his role in preparing the way for Christ.



#### June 29 – Saints Peter & Paul

The Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul to honor the two great apostles. St. Peter, one of the Twelve and the chief of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and St. Paul “called to be an apostle, and Apostle to the Gentiles.” Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of the Emperor Nero. This is a very special feast day for Fr. George, as it is the anniversary of his ordination.

Our branch will not meet in July so our members can enjoy their family vacations. Rest and relax with your friends and family and enjoy the warm summer days!



## Diocese of Alleppey

The Diocese of Alleppey is located in the south west coast of India. The majority of the population in the area are poor fisherfolk who live on their daily catch. The Diocese of Alleppey, along with her social services and other ministries, works hard to support the Lord's less fortunate to her level best.

Though the faithful contribute their share to the common fund of the diocese, many parishes, schools, and other institutions are maintained by the diocese. Most of the times needs like housing, education, and medical care of the poor are partly attended to by the diocese. To a certain extent, the diocese support the professional and advanced studies of the youth from poor families by giving scholarships.

This year, the proceedings from Missionary Cooperative Appeal will support the following programs in the diocese:

A number of people in the diocesan area suffer from cancer and other terminal diseases. There are very few government welfare programs or insurance plans for the poor villagers. The unfortunate cancer patients in the area will be helped by the hospice and palliative care center run by the diocese.

The diocese also has a plan to help those who have lost land and homes due to sea erosion, to buy land, build a home, or repair homes damaged by heavy monsoon.

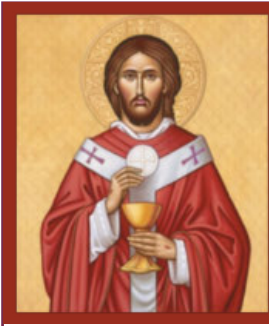

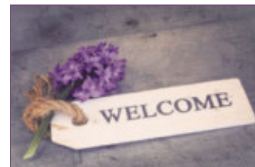
