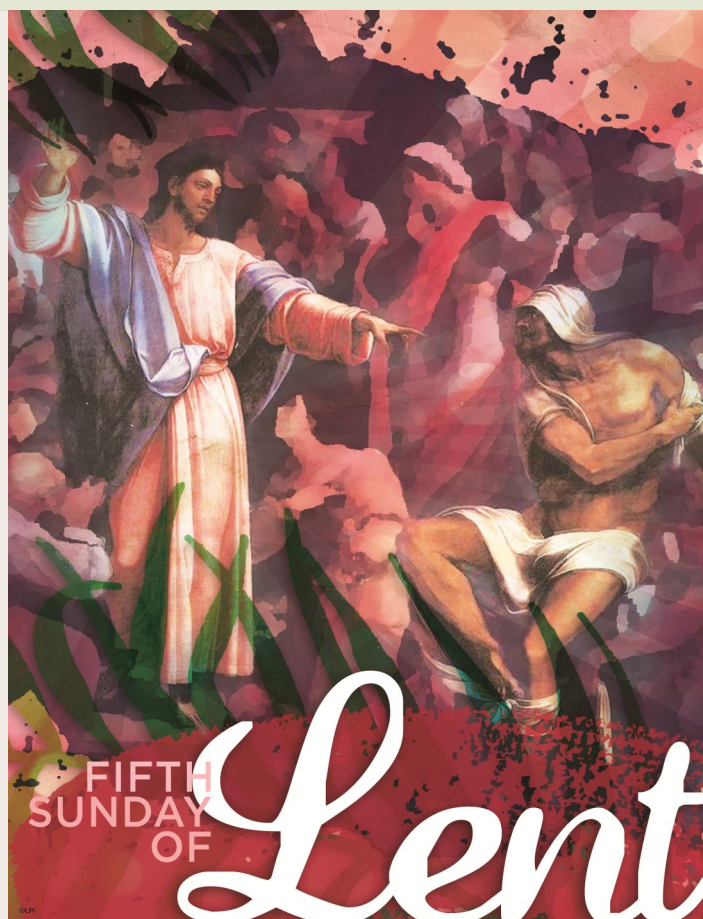

Salubong - Easter Sunday



After the Resurrection, there is a tradition affirmed by St. Ambrose of Milan and St. Ignatius of Loyola that the Blessed Virgin Mary encountered her Son, the Risen Christ. This tradition is portrayed in the pious procession known as "Salubong" in the Philippines and "Encuentro" in Spain. "Salubong" literally means "meeting" or "encounter." From separate directions, a procession of men bearing the image of the Risen Christ and a procession of women bearing the image of the Blessed Virgin Mary meet in the church. In this dramatic reunion of the Risen Christ and His Sorrowful Mother, we will see Mary's deep sorrow at the loss of her Beloved Son turn into indescribable joy! The black veil of mourning will be lifted from Mary by one of the children dressed as an angel, who leads the assembly in the singing of the Easter Marian Antiphon, "Regina Caeli, Laetare" (Queen of Heaven, Rejoice).

At dawn (5:00am) on Easter Sunday, April 5, we will hold the traditional **Salubong**, as we have for over 10 years at St. Clare. This will be followed by Mass at 5:30am.

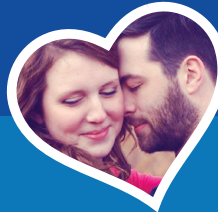
