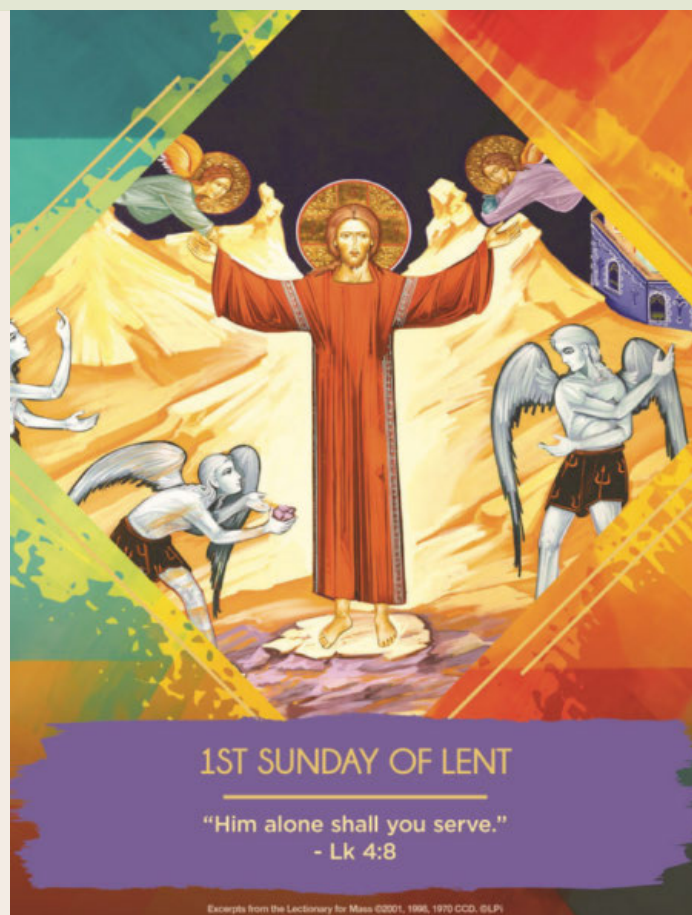

ICF is celebrating St. Joseph's Day this year on March 15-16 after every Mass. There will be a table in the Narthex, as has been our tradition.

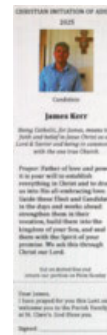

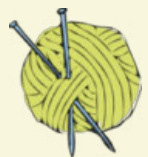
Taizé Holy Hour - Monday, September 23 at 7:00pm

Thank you to all those who returned your backpacks filled with hygiene and other items. As of February 26, we have given out 126 backpacks to Mercy Pedalers, 100 to the Church of Prophecy in Olivehurst (there's a large homeless population in Olivehurst), 60 to the homeless in Sacramento through the Missionary of Charity Sisters, 100 to a portable showers truck in Sacramento who give showers to the homeless, and 100 to Wellspring Women's Center in Oak Park. We still have about 150 left to hand out ourselves.

This month we are collecting canned chili, canned ravioli or canned spaghetti and meatballs, and canned chicken. If you help us like you did with the backpacks, there will be a lot fewer hungry high school students!! You are amazing and greatly appreciated!


