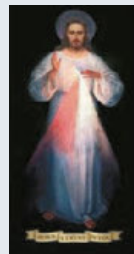

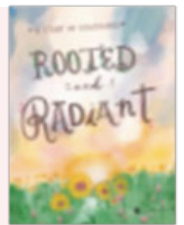

## St. Clare MOMS Ministry Spring Bible Study



In the *Rooted and Radiant* Bible study, we'll learn the book of Colossians verse by verse. We will seek to understand the challenges that faced the Colossians, recognizing that they are remarkably similar to our own challenges today.

Choose from two weekly sessions: Monday mornings 9:30-11:30am or Thursday evenings 6:30-8:30pm, starting the week of April 8 through May 13 (six lessons). Register for either day. *Please note, you cannot move between sessions as this is not a lecture format Bible study. It is a small group discussion format led by peer facilitators.*

### The St. Clare Parish Choir

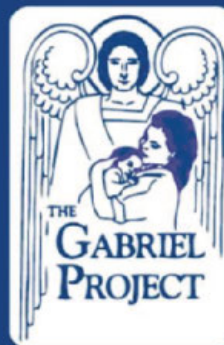
