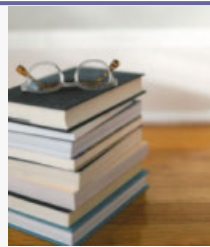
Pray for our Youth!

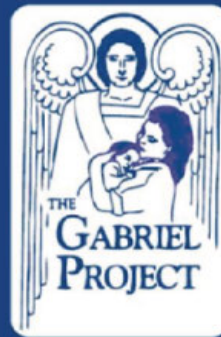
