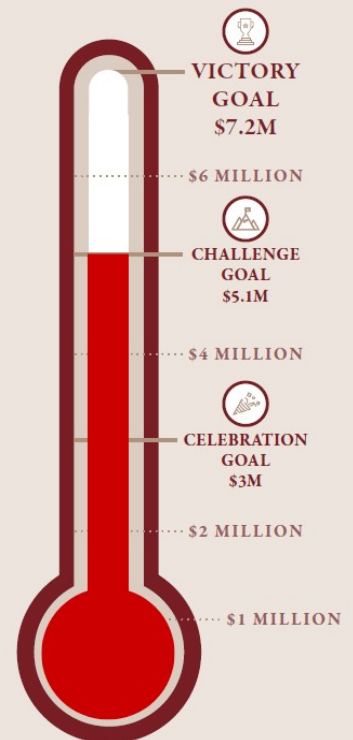

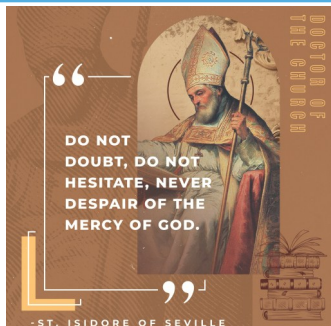
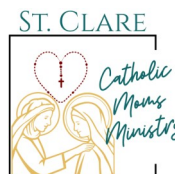

Thank you everyone for your generous donations of diapers and wipes for three local Life Centers. They are **all** most appreciative of the support you have shown the women who choose life!! This month they are asking for your support with canned raviolis and high protein bars (more than 10 grams of protein).

The clothes you donate through the Treasure Chest and the two black barrels go to several different places. The women's and kids' clothing go mainly to the Ukrainian refugees in No. Highlands. The items they don't need are taken to Mexico three to four times a year. We go out and serve the homeless with the men's clothing 10 times each month. When we get an abundance of clothing, shoes, blankets, tents, and sleeping bags, we help a couple of places in Sacramento. Other places we try to help at least every other month are Wellspring Women's Center and Showers by Touchstone (a portable shower trailer for the homeless). We recently gave sleeping bags, tents, and eight bags of clothing to Stand Down Placer for veterans in Placer County. Thank you for all your donations that make all these things possible!!

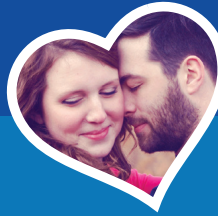

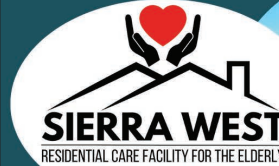
