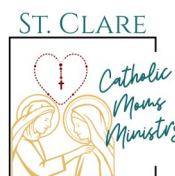

One more week to go for our collection this month! We are collecting canned ravioli and high protein (>10g) energy bars. Please help fill the shelves of our pantry for the high schoolers in need. On that topic, our volunteers served 1,540 meals through our meal bags (110 kids receiving 14 meals). We also gave out 14,800 pounds of food which equals out to 12,398 meals to the high school community. That community had 275 students, 600 adults, and 40 seniors for a total of 915!! It took about 70 volunteer hours to do everything mentioned above.

We also gave the Western School District a truckload of women's and kids' clothing on the 14th of this month. Thank you again for all you do to help!
