## SOCIAL CONCERNS

Last week we told you about our thriving ministry to help alternative high schools. This week we want to let you know about our homeless outreach ministry.

We go out to provide clothes, socks, shoes, sleeping bags, tents, blankets, socks, and coats **10 times each month!**

Every week, we help the Missionary of Charity Sisters in Sacramento. They bring food for 60 people and we bring all the items mentioned above.



Every other week we go to Sacramento to give out clothing and food from 4:15-5:00pm. The homeless know we are coming and we serve 25-40 men and women each time.

We also work with What Would Jesus Do (WWJD) here in

Roseville at the Methodist church on Church Street and Washington every Thursday from 8:00-9:00am. We provide the 40-55 men and women with clothing, tents, sleeping bags, socks, tennis shoes, blankets, and socks. Newer coats and sweatshirts go to the 225 families we register at Thanksgiving.

Next week, we will let you know what happens with the women and kids clothing you put in the Treasure Chest!

If you are looking to connect with your fellow parishioners, **ICF is for YOU!** Our monthly gatherings include a dinner and a business meeting filled with fun, laughter, and fellowship.

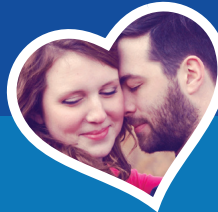

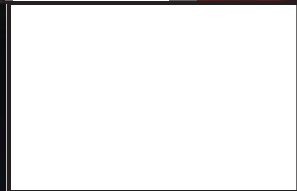
