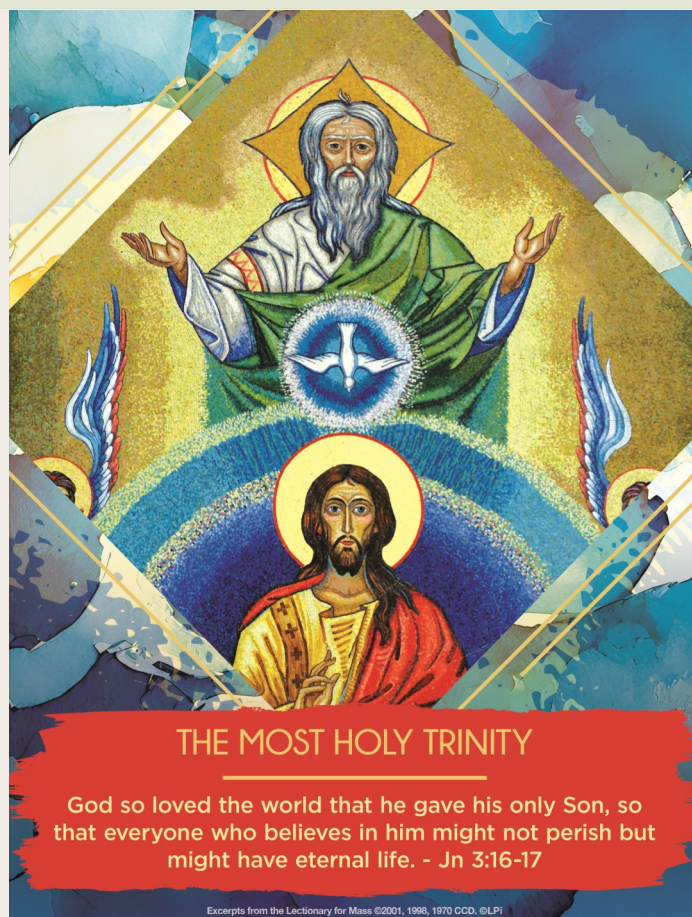

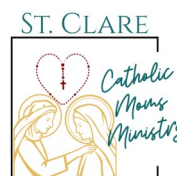

SOCIAL CONCERNS

Thank you to all who bring in the items requested each month or donate through the envelopes in the Treasure Chest. We can't do what we do without you! For the month of June, we are asking for T-shirts and shorts you no longer wear for those out on the streets. Of course, we are ALWAYS thankful for, and accepting, sleeping bags, tents, blankets, socks, tennis shoes, and towels.

We go out to the homeless 10 times each month to give out clothing, tennis shoes (about 20-25 pairs a month), sleeping bags (about 15 per month), and tents (about 5-10 per month). We limit each person to one pair of pants or shorts, two T-shirts, one jacket or sweatshirt (remember it's still chilly at night), two pairs of socks, and one hat. We don't give out tents or sleeping bags unless they ask us. Shoes are given out only if their shoes are worn out.

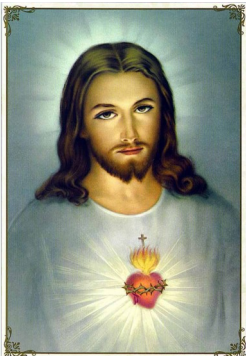
Sacraments at St. Clare
