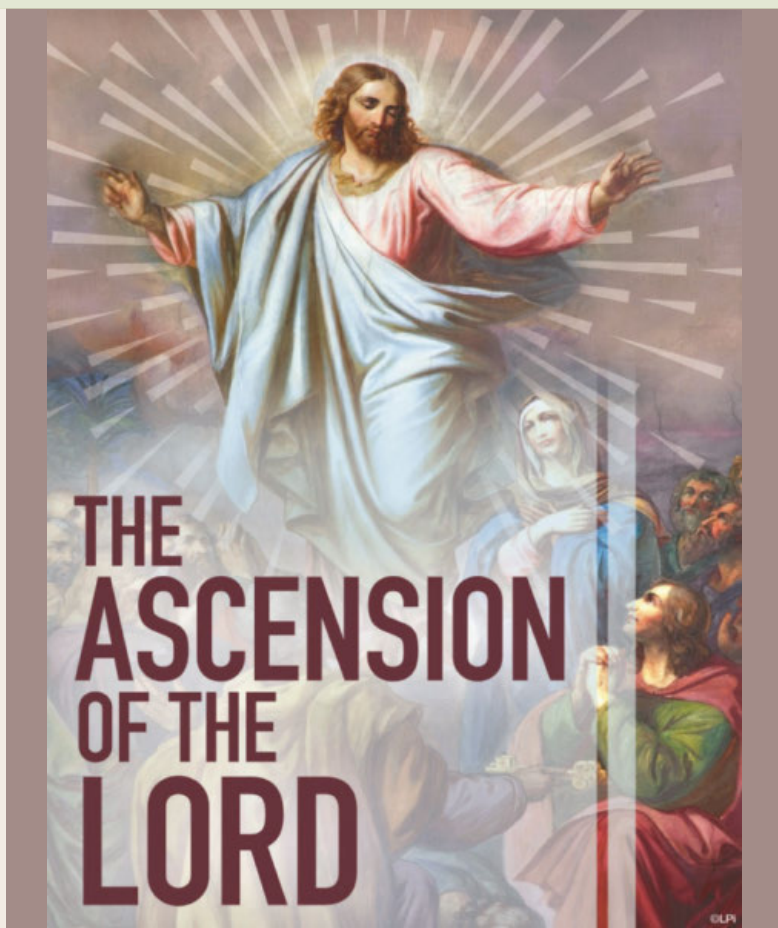

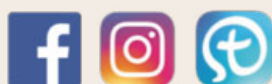

Divine Mercy Ministry The Hour of Mercy

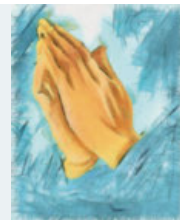
