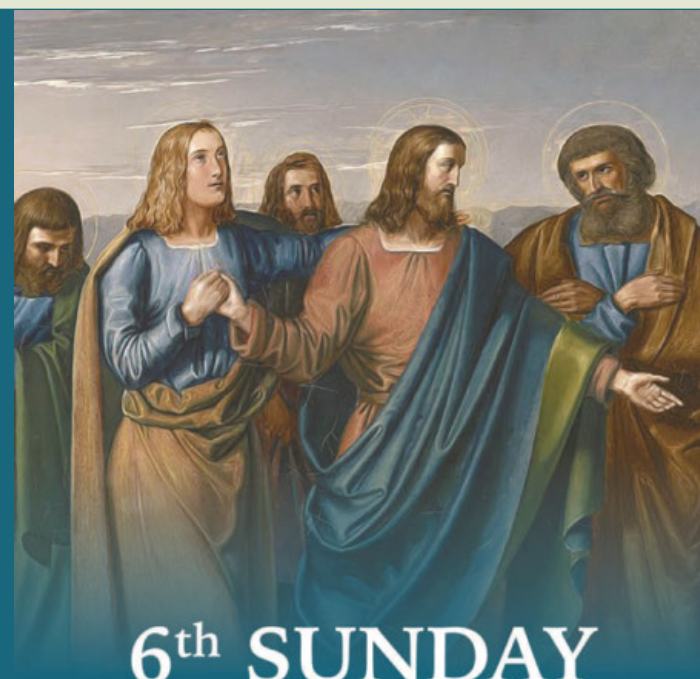

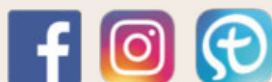

Who is Our Lady of Fatima?

May 13 is the first anniversary of the apparition of Our Lady to three shepherd children in the small village of Fatima in Portugal in 1917. She appeared six times to Lucia, 9, and her cousins Francisco, 8, and his sister Jacinta, 6, between May 13, 1917 and October 13, 1917. At her last appearance, residents of Fatima witnessed a stunning atmospheric event that became known as the Miracle of the Sun.

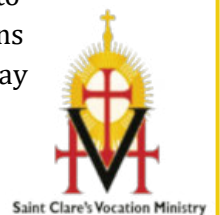

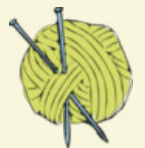
