A New Multi-Purpose Hall for Our Parish Family

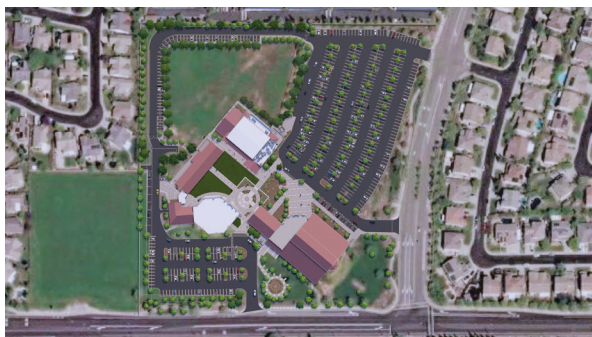
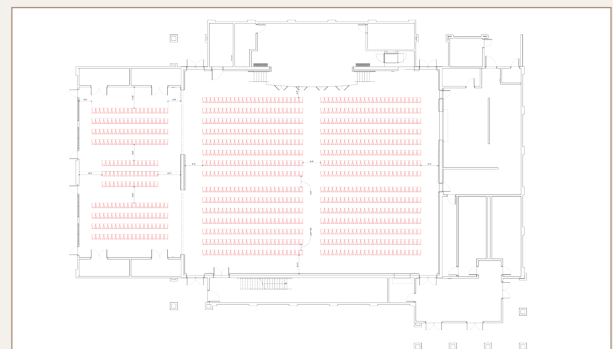
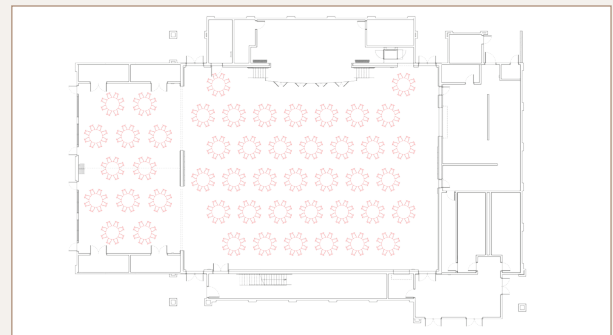
We are building a 16,000-square-foot Multi-Purpose Hall — a bright, welcoming space designed to serve every generation at St. Clare.

What our new hall will include:

- » Stadium seating for 700 people
- » Seating for 320 people at 40 round tables
- » Full gymnasium with regulation-size sport court
- » 24-foot ceilings with retractable bleachers
- » Elevated stage with vesting area / green room
- » Two flex meeting rooms seating up to 194 people
- » 1,200-square-foot commercial kitchen
- » Welcoming lobby with accessible restrooms
- » Concessions stand
- » Built-in storage throughout

WHY THIS MATTERS:

Our 71 ministries currently share tight or limited spaces. This new hall creates room to grow, gather and welcome.



Campus Improvements:

- » New loop road connecting North and South parking lots
- » 56 new parking spaces
- » Improved traffic flow
- » Environmentally efficient design with solar offsets
- » Sustainable landscaping

What is a pledge?
