What to expect when integrating pharmacogenetic (PGx) testing into your health




After a thorough review of the pharmacy claims data for Quality Widgets Company, several employees, including Pam, have been identified as favorable candidates for PGx testing. Many factors impact how a favorable candidate may be identified, including:

- Genetic factors
- Illness or organ dysfunction
- Food interactions
- Other medications



Pam and the others are offered the opportunity to participate in PGx testing.



Upon opting in, Pam receives a test kit that is quickly and easily completed via a cheek swab at home. Once complete, she places the swab into the prepaid postage packaging and mails it to the laboratory.
