The month of April gets its name from the Latin word *aperio*, meaning “to open [bud],” because plants really begin to grow now.

This Paschal Moon marks the first Full Moon of spring and is used to determine the date of Easter. Easter occurs on the first Sunday after the “Paschal Full Moon.” In simple terms, this is the first Full Moon immediately following the vernal (spring) equinox. However, that’s not the full story because Easter isn’t based on the actual Moon or equinox date! We’ll explain the curious connection between the Moon and Easter.

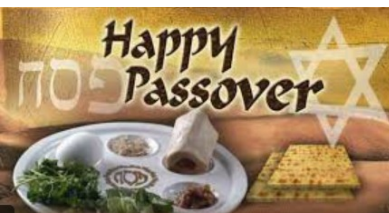
Happy April – a month of hope and awakening!

For the snowbirds, safe travels to the north and to our Florida resident friends, have a wonderful quiet summer. Looking forward to seeing everyone here this fall!

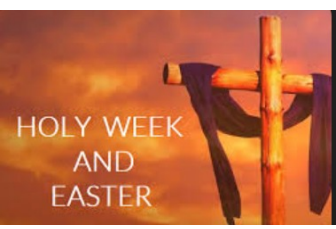

Passover is one of the most revered Jewish holidays, marked by families gathering worldwide for Seder dinners and cherished traditions. This holiday serves as a poignant reflection on Jewish history, customs, and beliefs, centering on the timeless narrative of freedom from ancient Egyptian bondage.

Passover 2026 begins at sundown on Thursday, April 2, 2026, and ends the evening of Thursday, April 9, 2026.

Historically, the word Passover refers to the death angel passing over the Israelites during the final plague, death of the first-born sons in Egypt. Following instructions to paint lamb’s blood on the doorposts of their houses in Egypt, God spared the Israelites and delivered them. Pass-over (*Pesach*) commemorates the Israelites triumphant deliverance from Egyptian bondage. Families and friends gather annually during the first month (*Nisan*) on the Hebrew calendar to recount the liberation and commemorate the meal eaten by the Israelites in Egypt on the original Passover. As instructed in Exodus 12:18, Passover begins and ends at nightfall, “In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at even, ye shall eat unleavened bread, until the one and twentieth day of the month at even.” (Even refers to evening.)



Holy Week is an important time for Christians throughout the world. Holy Week, the final week of Lent, begins on Palm Sunday, the Sunday before Easter. Holy Week is a time when Catholics gather to remember and participate in the Passion of Jesus Christ. The Passion was the final period of Christ’s life in Jerusalem. It spans from when He arrived in Jerusalem to when He was crucified.

Four special ceremonies commemorate the events of Christ’s Passion from His entrance into Jerusalem, when palm branches were placed in His path, through His arrest on Holy Thursday and Crucifixion on Good Friday, to Holy Saturday, the day that Christ’s body lay in the tomb. The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Triduum—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ’s Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Triduum marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

Easter Sunday, or Resurrection Sunday, is one of the most significant Christian holidays on the calendar. The day commemorates the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, who showed Himself alive after three days in the tomb. The first Easter Sunday changed everything, and every Easter Sunday after that reflects the joy, amazement, and worship those early disciples had when they first saw the risen Lord.

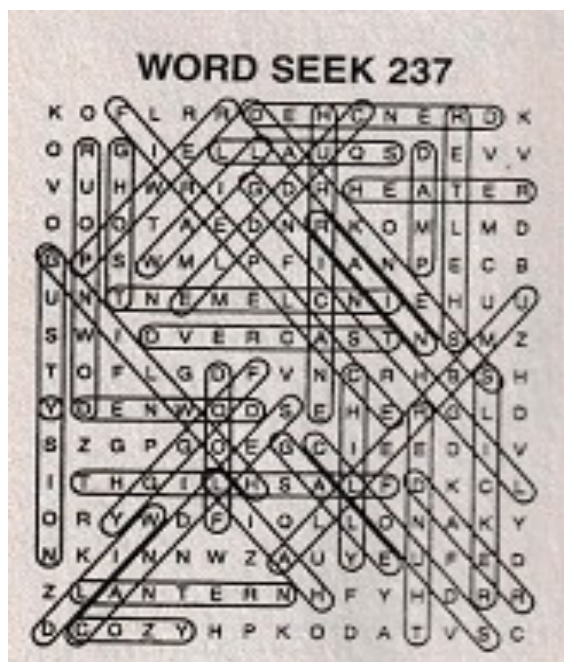


Communities throughout Florida are proclaiming April 10th as Gopher Tortoise Day and hosting events to share the importance of protecting gopher tortoises.

Gopher tortoises are considered a keystone species because they dig burrows that provide shelter for 360 other species of wildlife, called "commensals." These commensal species include the gopher frog, Florida mouse, the endangered eastern indigo snake, eastern diamondback rattlesnake, and hundreds of invertebrates like beetles and crickets. Without the gopher tortoise, many of these species would not have a home or would not exist. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and the Gopher Tortoise Council are two partners with excellent information about the gopher tortoise's appearance, behavior, habitat, threats, conservation and management.

Where to See Nesting Sea Turtles in Florida

Visitors are often surprised to learn that more than 100,000 threatened and endangered sea turtles nest on Florida beaches every summer. In fact, nearly 90 percent of sea turtle nesting in the U.S. occurs in Florida from March through October of each year.

What's even better is that you can see nesting sea turtles in Florida.

Up and down the Atlantic coast where sea turtle nests are most common parks and environmental groups organize nighttime sea turtle walks in June and July.

Getting a chance to see a Florida sea turtle in action takes some planning but those who've done it say it's a memorable experience.

On a typical turtle tour visitors are led to a spot on the beach where a sea turtle is digging a hole a foot or two deep with her hind flippers. The turtle then starts filling the nest with soft-shelled eggs the size of table tennis balls. After laying her eggs she refills the nest with sand and heads back into the ocean. The whole process takes 30 to 60 minutes.

On turtle walks, a hushed circle of humans watches the spectacle. Two months later, the eggs hatch and scores of tiny turtles emerge from the sand at night and clamber into the water.

Florida's most common variety of sea turtle is the loggerhead, which averages 200 to 250 pounds. Larger leatherbacks and green turtles nest here in smaller numbers but turtle walk participants are not allowed to watch them lay eggs because leatherbacks and greens are endangered and the presence of people might be disturbing to the nesting.

To see a sea turtle nesting on the beach you must go with a group: Turtle walk guides know the federal and state laws about what is and isn't permissible.

All sea-turtle walks require advance reservations.
