If you see something, say something, **do something.**

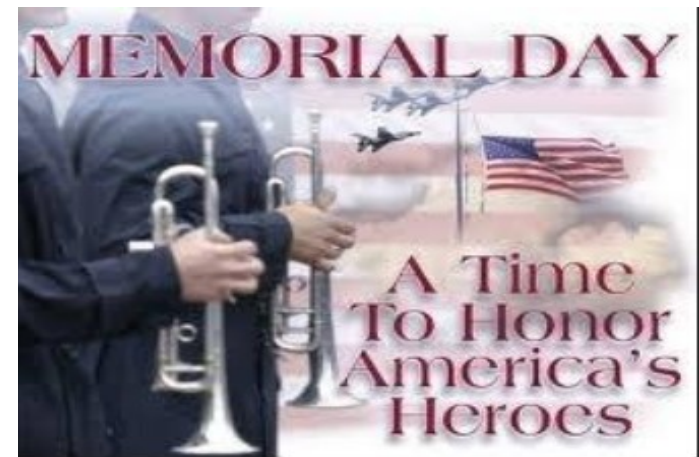

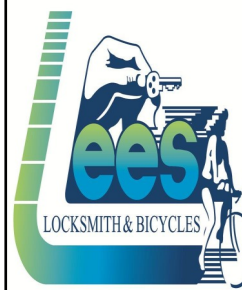

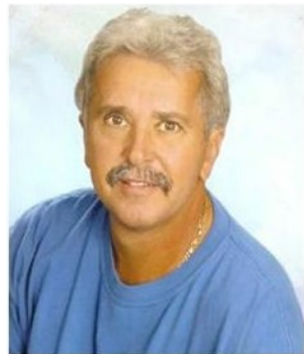

Bicycling is a fun and healthy way to get around and get your daily dose of physical activity. But before riding, make sure you and your bike are ready to ride.
