If you do not have a family doctor, you are welcome to continue to see our doctors at the Vital Path Addiction Clinic (VPAC). We make it really easy. Please text your name with the reason for the visit. We need to know the reason so we can book you with the appropriate provider. If you call, we may not be able to answer. By texting, we have the information and will respond within 24 hours (usually much sooner).

Please also note that you are also responsible for your own medication, costs, etc. VPAC is only responsible for ensuring that the prescriptions are written and faxed to the appropriate pharmacy. If you have any issues related to receiving your medication, please contact Joe's Pharmacy directly, or if you are using a different pharmacy, please contact them.
