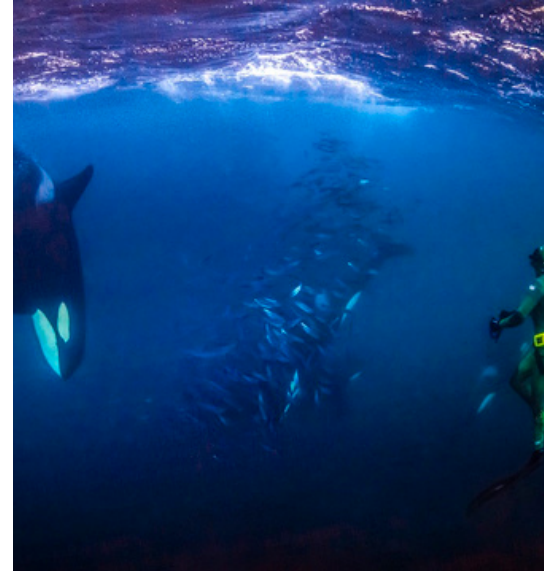

Swimming with Orcas

The experience of swimming with orcas has been around for more than 20 years. However, only recently has it become well-known and more available to tourists!

Experience the thrill of coming face-to-face with one of the ocean's most awe-inspiring creatures—the magnificent Orca. Led by our expert guides, you'll journey aboard the expedition vessel to prime locations in the Arctic, scanning the icy waters in search of orca pods.

Once a pod is located, the excitement builds. You'll suit up in a thick wetsuit, hood, fins, weight belt, and gloves—preparing for an unforgettable swim in the frigid, crystal-clear Arctic waters. With gear secured and cameras ready, you'll step from the expedition vessel into the sturdy, maneuverable Zodiacs, bringing you even closer to the orcas in their natural environment. From this vantage point, we observe their fascinating behaviour, waiting for the perfect moment to enter the water for a breathtaking, up-close encounter.

Whether you're a seasoned free-diver or prefer to float and simply take it all in, you'll be captivated by the grace, intelligence, and raw power of these incredible marine mammals. While orcas are wild and their movements follow nature's rhythm, the liveaboard vessel ensures we're always in the best possible position to observe—and when nature allows, to swim alongside—them.

Get ready for a truly exceptional marine experience that will stay with you forever.





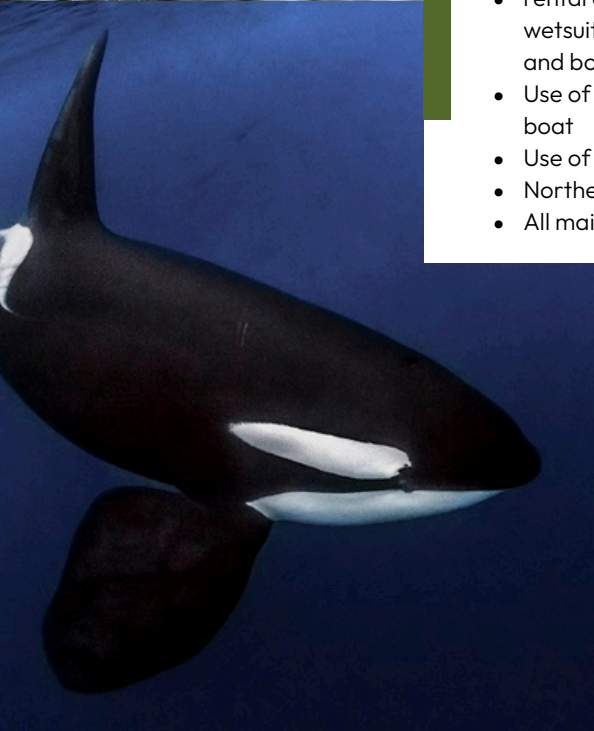
Gearing up

Getting ready for your orca encounter starts with gearing up properly. Here's what to wear in the icy winter waters of Norway to keep warm, comfortable, and ready for an unforgettable swim.

We provide a briefing and demonstration on the importance of wearing an open cell wetsuit for snorkeling with orcas in Norway's cold winter waters. These suits offer essential insulation and warmth, allowing for extended time in the water. We'll also show you the best and easiest way to put the wetsuit on using a soapy water mixture, ensuring you protect the delicate lining and achieve a snug, comfortable fit. You can either bring your own gear or we can fit you out with the hire gear (included in your package)

Included in your package:

- 7-9mm freedive wetsuit
- Opencell neoprene socks & mitts
- Dryrobe or windproof poncho
- Crocs or deck shoes
- Mandatory: Yellow/orange snorkel & mask strap for visibility
- Rental equipment includes all the above plus weights, thermal suit, and accessories

All twin suites with ensuite
- Guided whale swimming
- 2 zodiacs: 1 Expedition leader (in water) + 1 skipper on each zodiac

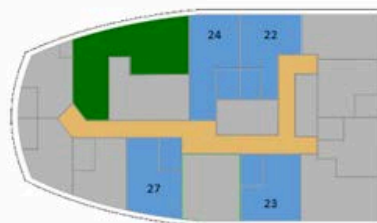

MS Freya





M/S Freya

M/S Freya is a heavy duty expedition ship built in 1981 to Lloyds Ice Class 1A. Being 45 meters long and 10 meters wide, she is a big ship with lots of space to move around.

Freya was named after the Norse goddess of love and beauty. She was refurbished in 2024 and comfortably accommodates 12 guests in an intimate and cozy atmosphere. Our 9 experienced and friendly crew onboard Freya will make you feel right at home.

Guest Cabins

Freya offers 9 spacious guest cabins as deluxe twins, deluxe singles and one deluxe suite. All are located on the main deck and upperdeck and have a private bathroom, plenty of space for storage and minimum 1 window.

The single cabins are similar size to the twins, and main difference is they are used for single occupancy rather than double.

The deluxe suite is larger with a seating area, 2 windows and choice of single beds or a kingsize bed.



Restaurant & Lounge areas

Delicious meals are served in the restaurant area on the main deck. You will also find our well stocked bar in the restaurant.

The cozy sofa lounge is great to hang out and relax. Perhaps have a coffee or go through your photos on the large screen.



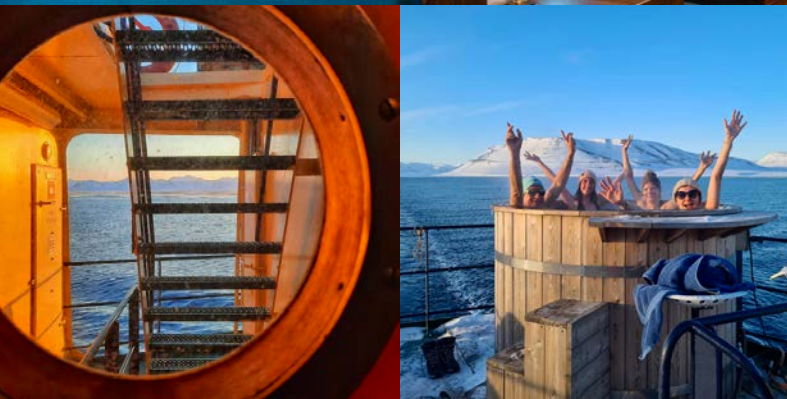
Panoramic Hot tub & Sauna

There is no better way to end the day than in the hottub located on the topdeck. Here you have impressive panoramic views of the fiords and the arctic sky with northern lights.

Or go for an arctic dip and the indoor sauna to get really heated up.

Zodiacs

We run 2 zodiacs with one in-water guide and one skipper on each. The zodiacs are six meters long and licensed for 12 persons, but we limit numbers to max 6 guests to keep the groups small and provide you the best encounters



Equipment Room

You will have a private space for hanging your suit and storing gear in a heated and ventilated room inside the ship. So your gear will be dry and warm for you to put on every morning.
